Applications for winter semester should be sent before June 15th, after that date we cannot guarantee the accommodation at the student residence hall. As soon as we receive required documents we issue the Letter of Acceptance.

- LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS:

Please take note that students must know the foreign instruction language (English/German) at an **intermediate (B2)** level in order to follow the lectures and complete assigned projects. The knowledge of foreign language can be randomly checked upon arrival.

-Accommodation :

- DORMITORIES

Most of the students accepted to study at our University in a frame of Erasmus+ Programme are granted housing in one of our 4 dorms. Due to limited places in dorms please pay attention that only a given number of students will be granted a place. After the selection of students those who were chosen to have accommodation in dorms will be informed by email.

Students who apply late might not be granted a dorm slot. Disabled candidates are kindly asked to contact our office. We have 2 double rooms adapted to the needs of students with disabilities.

- PRIVATE HOUSING - ACCOMODATION IN THE CITY

Many students prefer to live in private accommodation as this allows them to live with a group of friends and enjoy a greater degree of independence and flexibility. Priority for accommodation in dorms given to those students who are accepted as first. Students who cannot be offer dorm housing or student interested in living in the apartment are encouraged to seek accommodation in the private sector due to limited rooms available in our halls.
